ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE TITLE 2 (ADMINISTRATION) TO ADD CHAPTER 2-18 (BALLOT PROPOSITIONS) RELATING TO THE ASSIGNMENT OF ALPHABETICAL LETTERS TO IDENTIFY BALLOT PROPOSITIONS IN FUTURE ELECTIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. City Code Title 2 (Administration) is amended to add a new Chapter 2-18 (Ballot Propositions) to read:

Chapter 2-18. - Ballot Propositions.

§ 2-18-1 - Ballot Proposition Labeling.

- (A) Ballot propositions will be assigned the next available letter of the alphabet that follows the last letter used by the ballot proposition from the previous municipal election. Once the last letter of the alphabet is used, ballot propositions will reset to the first letter to the alphabet.
- (B) If the count of ballot propositions for a municipal election exceeds the remaining letters of the alphabet, then ballot proposition labels may be reset to the first letter of the alphabet without utilizing the remaining letters of the alphabet.
- (C) If a municipal election features more than 26 ballot propositions, then starting with the 27th proposition, double letters will be used as the proposition label. Then, the following municipal election will reset to the first letter of the alphabet.
