Additional Backup Information:

This contract was required to relocate utility equipment and materials from five Austin Energy facilities to their new Cameron Warehouse. Prompt relocation was necessary to consolidate inventory into a secure, centralized location to support construction and maintenance efforts across the Austin Energy service territory.

A formal, competitive solicitation process for moving services was initiated; however, these solicitations were cancelled due to the critical timeline for Austin Energy's relocation. The Financial Services Department conducted an informal competitive process and selected Expert Relocation Systems, LLC, as the provider offering the best value to the City.

Given the urgent nature of the facility relocation and the limited time available to complete the move, the contract was executed prior to Council approval.
