

1 **RESOLUTION NO.**

2 **WHEREAS**, the 2018 Meet and Confer Agreement between the City and  
3 the Austin Police Association (APA) will expire no later than March 31, 2023; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the Austin Police Oversight Act (APOA) is a petition initiative  
5 that, if enacted, will affect meet and confer negotiations between the City and the  
6 APA; and

7 **WHEREAS**, if the City Council places the APOA on the May 2023 ballot,  
8 the City Council desires also to provide consistency and predictability for police  
9 officers between March 31, 2023 and May 31, 2023; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

10 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

11 If the City Council places the Austin Police Oversight Act petition initiative  
12 on the May 2023 ballot, and if the 2018 Meet and Confer Agreement has been  
13 extended to March 31, 2023, the City Manager is directed to ensure, if necessary,  
14 that Austin Police Department police officers continue to receive the compensation  
15 and benefits provided in the 2018 Meet and Confer Agreement through May 31,  
16 2023, including the payment of sick leave on separation.
