## RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation's planned Loop 360 Program will improve mobility and safety in certain intersections along the Loop 360 corridor, including the construction of shared use paths; and

**WHEREAS**, the planned Loop 360 Program will leave extensive gaps between interchanges where a separate shared use path will not be constructed; and

**WHEREAS**, Loop 360 provides primary access to west Austin, provides access to Lake Austin and Travis County greenbelts, and is a popular recreational bicycle route; and

WHEREAS, grant funding will be available through the Texas Department of Transportation's 2023 Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program for public sector entities focused on active transportation network enhancements; NOW, THEREFORE,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council authorizes the City Manager to submit a grant application to the Texas Department of Transportation 2023 Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program to fund a feasibility study, environmental clearance, and potential construction of shared use path along SL 360 from Loop 1 to US 183.
