



Fiscal Year 2021-2022, precipitating the need to increase funding from the prior Request for Council Action. The City's 2019-2024 Consolidated Plan notes the need for youth services for low-income families.

Integral Care will provide fiscal oversight and quality assurance for the youth and family services network established under this agreement. Additionally, the agreement will continue existing Community Development Block Grant Youth Services Program services.

The Housing and Planning Department designated Integral Care as a subrecipient for the Community Development Block Grant Youth Services Program federal contract for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 based upon their experience of more than 20 years. The federal contract will be administrated by the Austin Public Health Department.
